Donna has attended trainings in North Carolina and Reno, Nevada, and has provided training in Omaha as part of the ONI team. Theaters in Omaha now providing AD as a service include the Omaha Community Playhouse, Orpheum, Blue Barn, Circle Theater, Shakespeare on the Green, and Film Streams.
